

SEDD AFRICA'S REIMAGINE US 2026

ELIGIBILITY

- There are two age-categories considered in this competition: Ages **14 - 18** and **19 - 25**, with one winner emerging under each category.
- Competitors can only participate under one category regardless of their academic status.
- Competitors less than **18 years** must fill this form in the presence of a legal guardian. Failure to do so will disqualify your entry.
- Your submissions may be moved to a different category at the discretion of the assessors. When this is done, you will receive an email informing you.
- One exceptional entry will be shortlisted under each category for a publication deal. **Shortlist can be increased to two exceptional entries under each category at the discretion of the assessors.**
- Entries can be either be Digital Art, Audio-visual Art, or Storytelling but must be rooted in indigenous Nigerian cultures.
- Entries **must not** have been published anywhere publicly (**including being publicly shared on personal social media pages**).
- Where applicable, entries can be written or performed entirely in indigenous languages, but English language translations or subtitles must be submitted alongside.
- Story entries must be at least 6000 words in length (for plays, this is inclusive of stage directions)
- Audio-visual entries must be at least 10 minutes in length.
- Permissions must be obtained for stories carrying culturally protected content.
- Submissions from authors less than 18 years will not be accepted or processed until the appropriate sections are filled.
